



FRONTLINE FAITH™ - Help Support Our Military!

The Georgia State Council of the Knights of Columbus strongly endorses the Frontline Faith program in support of our military! This is a new statewide program that is building momentum, and we are asking you to get on board!

Those who have served know that a soldier can go for weeks or even months without seeing a Catholic chaplain. Currently, there are over 300,000 Catholic service men and women and only 281 Catholic chaplains. Frontline Faith provides an essential link between our Catholic service men and women and their faith and the Knights of Columbus.

FRONTLINE FAITH provides MP3 players, preloaded with Catholic content, to members of our Armed Forces. The MP3 players provide over 7 hours of spiritual content, especially as it pertains to military service. The FRONTLINE FAITH players not only fill the gap between visits from a chaplain, they provide the type of media that young service men and women appreciate and enjoy.

The players include a celebration of the Mass from the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, officiated by The Most Reverend Timothy P. Broglio, Military Ordinary of the Archdiocese for the Military Services; a "Warrior Rosary," conceived by Lynda MacFarland, the wife of a career military man, using the Sorrowful Mysteries and recited by the auxiliary bishops and chaplain priests of the Archdiocese for the Military Services; and prayers written and recited by children. Other programming on the players includes "Centurions of Rome," a presentation made by the late Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point; "The Mass Explained," by Father Larry Richards; an examination of conscience; and two-and-a-half hours of stories about faith in military life, told by troops in their own words, including "The Grunt Padre," about a priest who ministered to infantry soldiers, and the tale of a soldier who carried the Eucharist into battle.

The MP3 players come with a lanyard and run on a rechargeable battery. They provide real spiritual nourishment and support for the brave men and women serving our country. The Frontline Faith players feature the Knights of Columbus emblem and carry a special message from the Georgia State Council. They are available at no cost to every Soldier, Airman, Sailor, Marine, and Guardsman who wants one. We see this not only as a powerful means of supporting members of our Church, but also as a means of evangelizing our Catholic faith. This initiative also provides the Knights of Columbus with the opportunity to attract new members to our organization.

A donation of \$24 puts a Frontline Faith player in the hands of one of our troops. Imagine how many players we can send if all of the Councils and Assemblies in Georgia participate in this statewide initiative. How many souls will be saved? The Frontline Faith players are care packages for the soul.
